Hobo Railroad Station


November 8th at the Hobo Railroad in Lincoln NH was a cool morning, about 25 degrees and overcast. Is that snow? No, just frost. The weatherman suggested it would clear but it didn't look good at 7:30 AM. Were those sticky tires going to stick to that cold tarmac? Will we have to run the street tires? Well, the sun did come out, the tarmac heated up, the tires stuck and we were in shirt sleeves by noon. What a beautiful day for a race.

Ten teams, forty drivers, all of them with considerable experience. SCCA's Secret Pimps are back with that awesome Z06. How many times have they won this? Cumberland Motor Club from Maine is here with three teams. The Sidecar Racing team with that very fast MR2 that set fastest time in a car in yesterday's autocross. Team Brockman has a set of Maine's top drivers in a Miata and Spin Cycle with one of those always fast Civics. The Sports Car Club of Vermont has two formidable teams. The Hose Head team has four of Vermont's best in an S2000 and the Last Hurrah team has four more good drivers of Vermont's best in the Saturn that took first and second yesterday in the Sticky Stock class. New

Hampshire has four teams with many of its best drivers. Quite a group of talented drivers which is going to make for a good competition. The team with the fewest errors will probably win.

Registration, tech and the drivers meeting is over and it's 9:30 AM! We get to our work stations and start practice. Three runs for everyone before lunch.

The course design has a good balance between fast and finesse. A slow start with a sharp left, let the rear settle and step on it. Get into second as soon as possible and carry the speed deep into the decreasing radius right, let up on the throttle and get the car to rotate. Get back on it with a little finesse (too much too soon and spin). Tap the brake and turn into the increasing radius left. Get back on the gas early and cut the turn's exit cone close on the driver's side. A slight jog to the right after the cone in the middle of the straight, hard on the brakes and turn left. Hug the inside left then hug the inside right. Drift to the outside at full throttle



by the train. Tap the brakes, turn right, wait for rear to settle and go hard. Three fourths of the way down straight, the second cam kicks in. Brake hard at the end of the straight, turn right and get on the gas early. Do another lap exactly the same; however, the speed into that first right is much higher and will require some brake. Remember to go straight into the stop box at the end of the second lap. Wow, what a great course for such a small space.

Practice was interesting. Several off courses, spins and cones but, ultimately, some extraordinary times. Will we see these 67s and 68s in the competition this afternoon when any mistake could cost you a win? Let's have lunch and find out.

Donna Stevens has made arrangements with a local deli for subs for the 40+ of us at 12:15. Donna and Jocelyn MacDonald went shopping last night for beverages and dessert. Donna and Elaine Roundy went to get the subs at 11:30. Good thing they were cold as we never got to them until 1:15. Lunch was great. Thank you ladies for taking care of us and thank you to Mike Ruggiero and Lays for the chips.

We were able to get our competition runs started by 1:40 PM. It will take us about two hours to get in two runs each. *Note: all times in the following tables are penalty and PAX adjusted.*

At the end of the first run the top two cars are less than 4/100ths apart and the top five cars are all within 1.2 seconds. Team Brockman is in the lead but their car is smoking with differential oil dripping onto the exhaust. Team Need 4 Speed gets an off course which will be hard to overcome unless others have similar fates and White Lightning picks a cone.

In the third run Purple Haze sets the fastest run of the day with a raw time of 68.767 and Sidecar Racing putting in the fourth fastest run of the day. White Lightning has its best run of the day which once PAX adjusted is among the better ones of the day. Hose Head picks up a cone. None of this changes the standings. Team Brockman's car is being referred to as the "Smoking Miata" as the leak in the differential has become significant and the car is banned from the grid.

Six cones and a costly spin brings more changes at the top. Purple Haze picks up a cone and a spin costing them about twelve seconds dropping them to fourth. Last Hurrah, Sidecar Racing and Hose Head all pick up a cone and White Lightning picks up two.



Run eight, the last run. Sidecar Racing spins costing them about 15 seconds and drop to fifth. Hose Head have their best run of the day which is the second best PAXed run all day. The Secret Pimps have the second best raw time of the day and pull even further ahead.
