Minutes of the Meeting – September 3, 2025

Call to Order: SCCNH President Ian Cook called the seventh business meeting of 2025 to order at 7:00 P.M.

Secretary's Report: A motion was made to accept the August 6 2025 minutes as submitted. (Drew/Alison)

Treasurer's Report: Alison reports that the accounts are in good standing. (Alex/Michael)

Membership Report: Dan reports that we have 306 total members at this time, 294 regular and 12 life. (Alison/Michael)

Programs

Autocross Report: Ian reports for Alex that autocross #3 and #4 were successful. Neither event was sold out due to multiple events around the same time. The next set of events is October 11th and 12th. It needs to be added to MSR. There were an unusual amount of requests for loaner helmets. The hillclimb helmet requirements are more stringent than autocross so we will see if we can get donations from that program.

Hillclimb Report: Laura reports for Calvin that things are looking good for this weekend. We still need a COI but everything else is on track and in progress. We still have low signups again similar to the spring event. 20 volunteers and 33 drivers so far online. Park is holding a general public outreach event about the hillclimb that Calvin will help facilitate on Saturday.

CTTC Report: Howard reports that we have secured several sponsors for the event and are working hard on others. There has been some great social media work for the event.

Gravel Trials Report: Scott reports that we had a great event a week ago. There were 17 entries that got 12 runs and lots of new volunteers. There is discussion around getting more HAM licensed volunteers. The confirmed dates for upcoming events are 11/16 (last event of 2025) and 1/11/26.

Rally Report: Drew reports that we had a rally with 10 entrants that all made it to the end. About half the teams went on the Mount Washington in the afternoon. The next event is the Turkey Trot November 9th. March 1st 2026 will be the Frost Heaves Rally.

Club History: Charlie reports that he has sent out a report on the life member nomination. He is planning on being at the 70th anniversary party with a small display and history talk. He requests \$50 (Drew/Scott). Motion passes.

Old Business and Action Items

Gravel Cross: The event is happening November 22nd at the Best's farm. SCCA is providing all equipment and we need to provide 1-2 porta-potties. Fee will be ~\$80/participant for 40 entries. We will setup a discount code for membership for the event to make it ~\$5.

Holiday Party: We are secured at the Autopac for December 6th. Harts is giving us the same base rate as 2024 but other fees have increased. Motion to set the price to \$40/person (Ian/Michael). Motion passes.

70th Anniversary/November Meeting: Ian spoke with the museum and they are good for our date. They would like to solicit our members for membership plus a donation from us. We will set up the event in MSR and do a Facebook post and email blast. Monica designed t-shirts. We can add this to the event for purchase at \$25/shirt. Ian will set up the shirts for drop-shipping due to lead time on the orders. Rebekah will get a cake with the shirt design on it.

Board Election/Bylaws: Bylaw update proposals and board nominations are needed for the October meeting.

Judy Fry: Judy's son is going through her items and there is a lot of SCCNH memorabilia. Charlie will be taking some and we will see if the Autopac Gallery or the Museum would like any of it.
