Secretary's Report: A motion was made to accept the September 3 2025 minutes as submitted. (Drew/George)

Treasurer's Report: Alison reports that the accounts are in good standing. (Charlie/Calvin)

Membership Report: Dan reports that we have 317 total members at this time, 305 regular and 12 life. (Drew/Charlie)

Programs

Autocross Report: Alex reports we have the last Canaan weekend of the season coming up. Both days are half full at the moment. Discussion will start this week for next year's dates and we are going to try to work with the other clubs to space out events. Motion for \$700 for loaner helmets (Drew/Calvin). Alison suggests an inventory of loaner helmet requests prior to spending money and it will be taken at the next event. Motion passes.

Hillclimb Report: Calvin reports that we had the 2nd hillclimb of the season. Attendance was low but we got 6 runs each day. Radios and timing worked great all weekend. We still need a more permanent radio crew. Insurance was a challenge for this event. 2026 dates will be discussed with the state soon. There is one more NEHA event this year, October 25-26. SCCNH is in charge of the NEHA banquet and the plan is to do the same setup as the holiday party.

CTTC Report: Howard reports that we have a contract with the mountain being worked on. Entries will open in November and volunteers will open in March. Drew is going to be treasurer for the event.

Gravel Trials Report: Scott reports that next event is November 16th and there are currently 8 entries. The program needs a second laptop and two tables for timing. Motion for \$700 for laptop and tables (Ian/Calvin). Motion passes. First 2026 event is January 11th.

Rally Report: Drew reports the Turkey Trot is November 9th. It will start near the track and end at Northwoods Brewery. There are currently 2 entries so we need some publicity.

Club History: Charlie reports that he is getting ready for his presentation at the holiday party.

Old Business and Action Items

Gravel Cross: The event is happening November 22nd at the Best's farm. The goal for registration opening and event announcement is Friday.

Holiday Party: Catering and venue are set with the downpayment paid. We still need to put the event in MSR. The board needs to review the points for the season for end of year trophies.

70th Anniversary/November Meeting: Ian signed a contract with the museum for the meeting. Event is going up in MSR this week. Shirts are up on Ian's site and any proceeds will be donated to the club. We need to confirm with the museum that BYOB is acceptable.

Board Election/Bylaws: No bylaw updates were presented for the election. Alex M, Laura, Hannah and Alison are running for their existing roles. Alex Q is self-nominating for President. Any additional nominations will be accepted until 6pm Wednesday October 8th.
