Secretary's Report: A motion was made to accept the March 4 2026 minutes as submitted. (Drew/Dave)

Programs

Autocross Report: Alex reports that the first two events are live in MSR and the school will be up shortly. Insurance and the track rental fee went up so we have increased the entry fee for the year. The 2026 budget is reviewed and approved (Alison/Mallory).

Hillclimb Report: Calvin reports that we have less than two months until Ascutney. SCCV is looking for more sign ups for Philo as there is a risk of not being able to run the event if there are not enough entries. We will send out an email to all CTTC entries with the 2026 schedule. The 2026 budget contains the actuals from 2025. Insurance has not been updated with the 2026 rate but we will have that soon and the fall entry fee will be updated if necessary. The budget is reviewed and approved (Dave/Scott).

CTTC Report: Howard reports that things are going well. The chiefs meeting is July 11th at the Common Man in Concord. There will be a virtual option available. Scott brought up a concern regarding staging logistics that was brought to him and the appropriate Chief is aware.

Gravel Trials Report: Scott reports that the May 24th event is live with 7 entries. The 3rd event of the year is scheduled for June 21st and no further dates until after CTTC. The budget is reviewed and is based on a break even of 12 cars (Calvin/Drew).

Rally Report: Drew reports that the next event is "The Search" on May 31st. The event after that will be September 27th and the Turkey Trot will be November 8th.
