OFFICIAL COMPETITOR WAIVER & CODE OF CONDUCT

I. ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the Mount Washington Climb to the Clouds. I agree to obey all instructions from workers and officials. I understand that the decision of the Event Chairperson or Race Official is final and binding in all matters.

II. COMPETITOR CODE OF CONDUCT

All competitors, crew, family, and guests must conduct themselves in a professional and respectful manner. Participation indicates acceptance of the following:

- **Professionalism:** Zero tolerance for harassment, threats, or abusive language toward officials, staff, or fellow competitors.
- **Substances:** Possession or use of illegal drugs is strictly prohibited. No alcohol may be consumed by competitors or crew during active racing hours.
- **Team Responsibility:** Competitors are held financially and legally responsible for the actions of their crew, family, and guests.
- **Property & Safety:** Participants must respect track property and equipment. Unsafe behavior that endangers any individual will result in immediate disqualification.

III. PADDOCK & FACILITY REGULATIONS

- **Paddock Speed:** A strict speed limit of 5 mph (or as posted) is enforced in the paddock.
- **Fire Safety:** Every entrant must provide at least one functional, one 5lb (or two 2 ½ lb) ABC rated fire bottle(s) in their paddock space, in addition to the system within the race vehicle.

- **Environment:** We operate a Carry-In/Carry-Out policy. All waste (trash, automotive fluids, tires, parts) must be removed by the entrant.
- **Restricted Access:** Children must be under active adult supervision at all times.
- **Conduct & Quiet Hours:** Participants must adhere to posted "Quiet Hours" for camping and paddock areas. Hours are 11 PM – 7 AM. Access is controlled by security; unauthorized entry outside of access hours is prohibited.
- **Vehicle Support:** Jack stands are required to be placed under a vehicle and on a solid base (¾" plywood square, or more) for any vehicle being lifted off the ground.
- **Animals:** There will be NO animals allowed at this event, unless they are a certified service/emotional support animal.

IV. ON-HILL & TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- **Safety Outside the Vehicle:** Competitors must follow all official protocols when on the hill or in transit areas while not actively racing.
- **Technical Inspection:** I understand that failure to pass technical inspection or the cancellation of the event (partial or complete) does not entitle me to a refund.
- **Protests:** Protests must be filed in writing to the Chief Steward within the designated timeframe specified in the event supplemental regulations.

V. ASSUMPTION OF RISK & MEDICAL CONSENT

- **Personal Responsibility:** I acknowledge that I am solely responsible for my own safety. I have full knowledge of the high-risk nature of the Mount Washington Climb to the Clouds.
- **Vehicle Risk:** Any loss, damage, or destruction of my automobile (or interest therein) is the sole burden of the entrant.
- **Medical Treatment:** I agree to be examined by medical personnel at any time and hereby grant permission for emergency medical treatment and/or transport to a medical facility.

VI. FINAL DISPOSITION

Failure to follow this Code of Conduct or the event regulations may result in warnings, fines, loss of points, disqualification, or permanent expulsion. Finally, I agree to maintain a positive attitude, not to whine or complain, and to ensure a safe, competitive, and enjoyable environment for all.
