Mandatory Requirements

- **Rookie Orientation:** All rookies must attend on Thursday from 5 PM – 8 PM. This is mandatory; attendance is recorded. Failure to attend will result in disqualification. Meet instructors and competitors in front of The Lodge.
- **Medical Forms:** Speedway Safety Services requires all entrants, crew, and volunteers to have a medical form on file. [Download Medical Form](#)

Racing Rules & Procedures

Rule changes

- A seatbelt cutter is required in all cars
- SA 2015 helmets will be accepted

Timing & Runs:

- Cars are timed at the Halfway Point ("Signal Corps") and the Finish.
- If Sunday runs are interrupted by weather, the halfway timing point may be used as the official time.

Flagging Protocol:

- **YELLOW:** Caution—unexpected situation ahead, but the racing line is clear. Proceed with care.
- **RED:** STOP safely and await instructions.

Start Order:

- Friday: First come, first served.
- Saturday: Fastest to slowest.
- Sunday: Slowest to fastest.

Start Procedure:

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- Sunday Start Line: Line up under control of Start Marshals. A staging area line exists past which no service personnel can assist the competition car.
- Staging: One car will be on the start line with another "on deck." When the lead car departs, the "on deck" car moves to the line.
- Green Flag: Once the course is clear (approx. 1 minute interval), you will receive the Green Flag. You have 10 seconds to start; timing begins when you break the light.
- Friday/Saturday: Procedures are more informal; instructions will be provided each morning.
- Upper Half Runs: Starts occur from a wide area near the Halfway Timing Point. Follow instructions regarding specific road or gravel start positions.
- Service Restrictions: No service is allowed during these runs; drivers who descend will not be permitted to return.
