Membership Report: Laura reports that we have 372 total members at this time, 359 regular and 13 life. (Charlie/Rob). MSR currently has a bug that flips membership status from Approved to New. We have a case open but no ETA on a solution.

Programs

Gravel Trials Report: Alex reports for Scott that there was an event in June that was successful. The next event is September 27th and it currently has 7 entries.

Rally Report: Drew reports that the next event is October 11th. It will start and end in Loudon. The Turkey Trot will be November 15th and the location is TBD.

New Business

Survey: Alex Q has a draft of a survey for members to provide feedback on our programs and events. He is going to send to the board for feedback before distributing it.

Insurance: Drew worked with several companies for CTTC insurance. He built a relationship with a broker and would like to see if they can get us a quote for the Council and all events run by the Council clubs.
